Pastor's Column

La Columna del Padre

No one likes one of those people who say, "I told you so", but I told you so. On April 11, I wrote regarding the abuse scandal* now affecting Europe: "Given his past actions, I strongly suspect [Pope Benedict] will in due time speak out clearly on the issue". As others in the Church (including some in the Vatican) blamed the media and other persons outside the Church for the issue, this week our Holy Father Benedict spoke.

While in route to Portugal, as is his custom, the Pontiff took time to speak to reporters about the plane. Unlike the melee that occurs with the American presidential press corps randomly yelling out questions, the Vatican press corps submits questions in advance and the Holy Father selects the ones he will answer. Thus, we can surmise the Pope chose to speak on this topic at this time. Asked if the message of Fatima could offer context for the current crisis affecting the Church with the abuse scandal*, the Holy Father said:

In terms of what we today can discover in this message, attacks against the pope or the church don't come just from outside the church. The suffering of the church also comes from within the church, because sin exists in the church. This too has always been known, but today we see it in a really terrifying way. The greatest persecution of the church doesn't come from enemies on the outside, but is born in sin within the church. The church thus has a deep need to re-learn penance, to accept purification, to learn on one hand forgiveness but also the necessity of justice. Forgiveness does not exclude justice. We have to re-learn the essentials: conversion, prayer, penance, and the theological virtues. That's how we respond, and we can be realistic in expecting that evil will always launch attacks from within and from outside, but the forces of good are also always present, and finally the Lord is stronger than evil.

In this carefully worded statement, we hear not only words of hope but also the recognition that this crisis began with clergy.

Briefly, next Sunday, the youth will have their year-end event at Gasper River. It has been a great year in our high-school youth ministry. All those graduating from 8th grade this year are invited to the event.

Finally, no word at this writing on who the next pastor will be or where I will be going. Hope to hear this week.

* I use the term "abuse scandal" rather than more explicit terms only because I am aware children sometimes read the bulletin.

Unas palabras que no se resuenen bien en las orejas de nadie son, "Te dije". Pero, les puedo decir que sí los dije. El 11 de abril, escribí sobre el escándalo de abuso que ahora afecta a Europa: "Dando cuenta de sus acciones pasadas, sospecho que en tiempo el Papa hablará claramente sobre la cuestión". Mientras otros en la Iglesia (incluyendo algunos en el Vaticano) culpó a la prensa u otras personas, esta semana nuestro Papa Benedicto habló.

Durante el vuelo a Portugal, como es su costumbre, el Pontífice habló con los reporteros en el avión. El cuerpo de prensa vaticano ya había sometido las preguntas, y el Santo Padre seleccionó los que quiso contestar. Podemos decir que el Papa eligió a hablar sobre este tema en este momento. Preguntado si el mensaje de Fátima podría ofrecer el contexto de la crisis que afecta a la iglesia por el escándalo de abuso, el Santo Padre dijo:

Los ataques al Papa y a la Iglesia no sólo vienen de fuera, sino que los sufrimientos de la Iglesia proceden precisamente de dentro de la Iglesia, del pecado que hay en la Iglesia. También esto se ha sabido siempre, pero hoy lo vemos de modo realmente tremendo: que la mayor persecución de la Iglesia no procede de los enemigos externos, sino que nace del pecado en la Iglesia y que la Iglesia, por tanto, tiene una profunda necesidad de volver a aprender la penitencia, de aceptar la purificación, de aprender, de una parte, el perdón, pero también la necesidad de la justicia. El perdón no sustituye la justicia. En una palabra, debemos volver a aprender estas cosas esenciales: la conversión, la oración, la penitencia y las virtudes teologales. De este modo, respondemos, somos realistas al esperar que el mal ataca siempre, ataca desde el interior y el exterior, pero también que las fuerzas del bien están presentes y que, al final, el Señor es más fuerte que el mal.

En esta declaración cuidadosamente redactada, oímos no sólo palabras de esperanza, sino también el reconocimiento de que esta crisis comenzó con el clero.

En otros temas, brevemente, el próximo domingo, el grupo juvenil celebrará el fin del año escolar en el Centro de Retiros Río de Gasper. Hemos tenido un año exitoso en nuestro ministerio juvenil. Todos los que van a entrar en la high school el próximo año son invitados.

Por último, en el momento que escribo esta columna, no he recibido noticias de quién será el siguiente pastor o a dónde voy yo. Espero escuchar esta semana.
