### Legion of Mary Rosaries

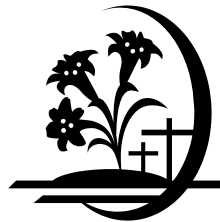
The Legion of Mary is furnishing rosaries during May in honor of Mary. They are in baskets in the front and back entrances of the church.

## La Columna del Padre

Finally, we have information to share regarding next year priests' assignments:

- Rev. Stan Puryear (that's me) will remain at Saint Joseph until August 9. After that date, I will be "on loan" to the Diocese of Bani, Dominican Republic.
- Rev. Andrew Garner will become the pastor of Saint Joseph Parish, effective August 9. Fr. Garner will remain as the diocesan Director of Vocations. Fr. Andy Garner was ordained to the priesthood for our diocese in 2001.
- Rev. Josh McCarty will become the parochial vicar (associate pastor) of the parish, effective August 10. Fr. McCarty was ordained in Owensboro in 2009.

Personally, I see the hand of our Lord at work in these decisions. Not only will I be pursuing an area of ministry to which I feel God is calling me, but I am elated to see such wonderful priests being assigned to this parish. Fr. Andy Garner is a wonderfully holy, prayerful, compassionate, kind, intelligent man and a great priest. He has worked diligently as the vocations director for the diocese over the past several years, and the results of his labors have been incredible. Although I do not know Fr. Josh McCarty personally, I have heard many very positive comments about his work at St. Stephen Cathedral. Both Fr. McCarty and Fr. Garner are bilingual in English and Spanish, and I see them continuing the work that has begun in this parish.

I have had a wonderful seven years being pastor of Saint Joseph, and during that time we have been through a great deal. This parish will always have a special place in my heart, and I plan to return here over the next few years when I get tired of sun, sand, and sea. (Fr. Andy is allowing me to store most of my personal possessions here, and I'll be using St. Joseph as my U.S. permanent address.) And I am very happy that two such wonderful men of God have been named for this parish. In fact, I predict that you will love and respect him so much that by January, the conversation will be: "Who was that bald priest here before? He was always taking a vacation."

- El Reverendo Padre Andrés Garner será el párroco de la Parroquia San José, efectivamente el 9 de agosto. El Padre Garner seguirá siendo director diocesano de vocaciones. El Padre fue ordenado al sacerdocio diocesano en el año 2001.
- El Reverendo Josué McCarty será el vicario parroquial de la Parroquia San José, efectivamente el 9 de agosto. El Padre McCarty fue ordenado en Owensboro en el año 2009.

Personalmente, veo la mano de Dios en estas decisiones. Yo voy a seguir un área de ministerio a que creo que Dios me llama, y estoy feliz en saber que esos dos sacerdotes maravillosos van a estar en la parroquia. El Padre Andrés Garner es un hombre orante, compasivo, e inteligente y un gran sacerdote. Ha trabajado diligentemente como el director de vocaciones en la diócesis por varios años, y los resultados de sus esfuerzos han sido increíbles. Aunque personalmente no conozco al Padre Josué McCarty, he oído muchos comentarios muy positivos de su trabajo en la Catedral San Esteban. Ambos Padres son bilingües en inglés y español, y creo que seguirán con el ministerio que se ha comenzado en esta parroquia.

Yo he disfrutado siendo párroco de la Parroquia San José por los últimos siete años. Esta parroquia siempre tendrá un lugar especial en mi corazón, y tengo intenciones de volver en los siguientes años cuando me canso de sol y playa. (El Padre Andrés me ha dado permiso guardar la mayoría de mis posesiones personales aquí, y estoy seré mi dirección permanente en los Estados Unidos.) Me siento muy contento sabiendo que dos hombres maravillosos de Dios llegarán a la parroquia. Me imagino que los van a querer tantísimo que ya en enero dirán ustedes: "¿Quién era ese sacerdote calvo que estaba aquí antes? Siempre andaba en vacaciones."


